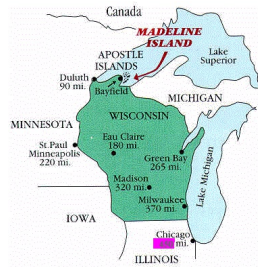


APOSTLE ISLANDS/W DULUTH

June 22-26, 2025
Sunday - Thursday
5 Days /4 Nights



As we travel to the Apostle Islands, our journey highlights the spectacular scenic shores that this area is known for. Join your friends at **Judy's Leisure Tours, Inc.**, as we enjoy these charming cities on Lake Superior.

1 Our first destination is Bayfield, WI where our adventure begins. **The Apostle Islands**, also known as the Twelve Apostles, are a group of islands in the southwestern portion of Lake Superior. The Apostle's were discovered and named by French missionaries, who originally believed there were only 12 islands. We will experience a **3-hour narrated cruise** of all 22 Apostle Islands. Our guide will touch on geology, history, legends, and lore. We will cruise past



historic **Raspberry Island** and **Devils Island** lighthouses and see the famous **Devils Island Sea Caves** which have been carved over thousands of

years by wind and waves. Our cruise will weave back through the Inner Islands, rich in history and natural beauty. Watch for eagles, loons, seagulls, and other wildlife. We check into the **Bayfield Inn**, for our **two night** stay.

2 Today, after **breakfast**, we will journey to **Madeline Island**, the largest of the Apostle Island chain. Located in Lake

Superior off Wisconsin's north coast, it is 14 miles long and 3 miles wide. It is the only one of the islands with commercial development. To reach Madeline, we board the **Madeline Island Ferry** at Bayfield for a 20 minute cruise to the port at LaPointe. An island **step-on guide** will meet our coach at the ferry landing. We will enjoy a narrated island tour, visit a **historic cemetery**, stop at the historic **Woods Hall Craft Shop** and enjoy some shopping on our own. We will also visit the **Madeline Island Historical Museum** where we will discover 300 years of colorful history. This afternoon we return to **Bayfield**, 'The Best Little Town in the Midwest' where we will enjoy a **guided city tour**. After the tour, we will experience a '**Victorian Dinner**' at the **Old Rittenhouse Inn**. Featuring a regional menu that combines Bayfield's freshest

delicacies with a country gourmet's artistry, this Victorian Inn offers an atmosphere amid antique and wood burning fireplaces.

3 Following **breakfast** this morning, we will make our way to Duluth, WI where we will have time for lunch and browsing this afternoon.



This evening we will enjoy a **Sunset Dinner cruise** aboard the **Vista Fleet**. As the crew casts off for our delightful cruise of **Lake Superior** and **Duluth Harbor** you can explore the ship before savoring your delicious meal along with beautiful music (often local musicians) and narrated highlights of the harbor. After you can relax topside to enjoy

the panoramic view of Duluth's unique skyline and harbor activity as we cruise this beautiful lake.

4 After breakfast this morning we will board our motorcoach and head to **Two Harbors**. We will have lunch and shopping before we continue our journey. Our day wouldn't be complete without a visit to the historic site of **Split Rock Lighthouse**, which was built atop a 130-foot cliff in 1910. The lighthouse served for nearly six decades as a guide for maritime traffic through the busy shipping lanes of Lake Superior. As you tour the center, you'll learn about the building of the light station and about life as a keeper in this remote. This evening we will have dinner.

5 Following breakfast we begin with a visit to the **Glensheen Historic Estate**. This 7.6 acre estate was built between 1905-08 by Chester A. Congdon. Glensheen resembles an English country estate in the early seventeenth century and looks much like it did when Chester and Clara lived here with their family. A significant part of Duluth's history has been preserved at Glensheen and is available today for many to experience. We will experience the opulence of the turn of the last century during our guided tour of Glensheen. Then experience a unique shopping experience in the Museum Shop. Next we will give you free time on the Canal area to have lunch and enjoy the scenery before its is time to "head for home". We will remember this beautiful tour and look forward to our next journey with our friends.

We depart for home with our new found friends as we reminisce about our travels and
